



We are very pleased to welcome you to the 14th AIRMAP Conference – 2025 edition – taking place at UVSQ (University of Versailles-Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines) / Université Paris-Saclay. The sessions are being held on the university campus within the dynamic urban community of Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines and will be complemented by celebrations in the beautiful and historic city of Versailles.

This year, the event gathers over 200 people from a variety of national and international backgrounds: faculty, researchers, practitioners, and public agents. The conference is organized over 3 days with plenary sessions and workshops, with contributions and exchanges in both French and English.

AIRMAP: A nationally and internationally recognized academic association

The International Association for Research in Public Management (AIRMAP) brings together institutions as well as French and foreign researchers specializing in the fields of public management and public policy. Its main objective is to promote multidisciplinary research in public and non-market management, actively contributing to the development and dissemination of knowledge in this specific field. It publishes two academic journals: Gestion et Management Public (GMP) and the African Journal of Public Management (RAMAP).

AIRMAP is driven by programs that address major societal challenges of the 21st century and operates in partnership with public actors and decision-makers at international, local, and territorial levels.

The 2025 edition of the AIRMAP conference is jointly organized by the LAREQUOI management research laboratory of the University of Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines, which specializes in cross-disciplinary and responsible management approaches, and the Graduate School of Management ISM-IAE, which offers Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctorate degrees in management for approximately 1,200 students each year

Conference Theme: "Responsible and Integrated Public Management: Between Tradition and Innovation"

The concept of responsible and integrated management, a founding theme of the LAREQUOI laboratory since its creation in 1998, is based on considering the interests and stakes of the various actors and stakeholders of organizations, along with ethical dimensions and the social, economic, and environmental implications of activities. It highlights the transversal operational logic, aiming to reduce siloed and compartmentalized approaches within organizations.

These elements are essential in the public sector, whose purpose is to serve the interests of all, while fulfilling its societal and inclusive missions. Responsibility is indeed a fundamental principle, although its implementation is always delicate, especially in a context of profound transformations. It is therefore necessary to seek a certain balance between, on one side, the traditional operations that govern and legitimize public action, and on the other side, the innovative or exploratory dimensions required for adapting public processes in a profoundly changing context. Balancing tradition and innovation is thus at the core of the AIRMAP 2025 Conference discussions.
